The Children's Bubbles Fund has previously paid for an important Blood Gas Analyser.



The entire Paediatric Team including, Doctors, Nurses, Ward Clerks, Domestics along with the patients and their families at QA Hospital have raised £30,937.25 for an important Blood Gas Analyser for the Children's Department.

The money was raised through various fundraising events throughout the year, such as sponsored bike rides, sponsored walks,

cakes sales, a charity car wash, a 12 hour dance-a-thon, Department raffles and many more! Donations were also kindly given by companies and supporters.

The staff had decided to fundraise for this piece of equipment, as the Department did not have its own Blood Gas Analyser before. This meant that the staff had to borrow Analysers from other Departments within the hospital.

Now the Department has its own machine, it will speed-up treatment, produce more accurate results and ensure that nursing staff are able to spend more time with patients and their families.

The staff worked with Portsmouth Hospitals Charity to raise the funds and to purchase the Blood Gas Analyser.

Portsmouth Hospitals Charity aims to support the patients of Portsmouth Hospitals NHS Trust by improving existing facilities and by providing additional equipment, supporting research programmes and innovation in the development of services and education to both patients and staff.

From the Children's Bubbles Fund



On the 4th March 2015, Hollie Brumwell, now 3 from Waterlooville was rushed to the Children's Assessment Unit with breathing difficulties following a bout of chicken pox.



When Hollie was admitted, the Doctors ran tests as her oxygen level decreased.

Hollie's Mum, Kate said, "The next day on Hollie's 2nd birthday it was confirmed by CAU that Hollie had Strep A, both lungs had collapsed and fluid was drowning her organs. She would need to be transferred to the Paediatric Intensive Care Unit and would need to have surgery to drain the fluid from her lungs.

Just before the team from Southampton arrived to take Hollie, she took a turn for the worse. The team were struggling to stabilise her when Hollie went into respiratory arrest.

A Surgeon on CAU opened her up at her bedside and placed a drain straight into her lung to drain 1/2 litre of fluid. Hollie was then put onto a life support machine.

The Children's Assessment Unit saved her life! They weren't waiting, they weren't hesitating, they were saving!

Numb, lost, heartbroken and surreal were just a few things I felt. I kept asking, I know she's poorly but is she going to be ok, is she going to live? 'She's very poorly, it doesn't look good' they said, 'every hour is crucial' they said. This happens to other poor families and I'm heartbroken when I hear about it. All of a sudden we are that family.

Now look at our girl, Specialists couldn't believe the recovery she made. Without her stubbornness and the hospital staff's strength, love and ability my world would be very different and we would be a very different family.

I struggle to not relive in my mind what we went through every day, but we are so blessed and so lucky.

We are eternally grateful to the Children's Assessment Unit and to the Paediatrics Intensive Care Unit. I owe them the world for letting me see my baby girl laugh, play, grow and to kiss her goodnight.

These people are guardian angels and they made a miracle come true in my life.
